



Cultural Heritage Fees for Service

Eastern Maar Aboriginal Corporation (EMAC) is the professional organisation that represents the Eastern Maar people of South West Victoria and manages their Native Title rights and interests.

EMAC has already had a consent determination over part of its country and has a further Native Title claim Registered with the Federal Court.

EMAC is both a Registered Aboriginal Party (RAP) and a RAP applicant under the Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006 (Victoria).

The current Eastern Maar Aboriginal Corporation Schedule of fees are;

- Provision of Field representatives* = \$1000 per day (+ GST)
 - Meeting attendance = \$400 per person (+ GST)
 - Travel to and from Warrnambool CBD = @ 73c per kilometre
(Applicable to all activities)
 - Accommodation (If Required) = \$150 per night
- The number of EMAC Field Reps required is usually two, but will be confirmed prior to job.
- All **requests for field workers require a minimum of one weeks' notice** via phone or email.
- All field workers will have a minimum of 15 minutes allocated for both morning and afternoon tea breaks; with a 30 minute lunch break, (1 hour total).
- On days of extreme weather conditions:-
- When the temperature reaches 32C, EMAC field representatives are required to work in the shade or have a 10 minute break every hour (in the shade). If the conditions are no longer safe, or the temperature exceeds 36C, the General Manager is to be contacted (Jeremy Clark).
